All teachers in the greater Tucson area are cordially invited to attend a **teacher in-service on Mission San Xavier del Bac** at the YWCA building located at 525 N. Bonita Ave, Tucson Arizona, 85745 on **August 24, 2019 from 8:30am to 12:30pm**. Mission San Xavier is a National Historic Landmark located just 10 miles south of Tucson, a unique and special place that is truly one of the great architectural and aesthetic treasures of Arizona.

At the in-service, docents will describe the Mission and explain its historic, religious, cultural and artistic significance. They will discuss how to schedule a class field trip to the site; and describe the educational resources that are available online to help prepare students to get the most out of a trip the MSX.

**Teachers who attend the in-service will earn four (4) professional development CE credits**, and we encourage teachers of all grades to consider attending the session. While most of the online learning materials are geared to the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> grade levels, where social studies curriculums focus on Arizona state history, Regions and Cultures of the Americas, and U.S. history, the Mission offers a rich learning experience for students of all ages.
